Boy's Format

- Keep Same Format

 placement based on Fall/Winter standings

Girl's Format

- Fall
 - Champions League (TOP NPL DIV) crowns NPL Champion
 - State Premier 1
 - State Premier 2
- Qualification for Fall
 - Year 1 (and U14) the seeding committee would be responsible for determining the Champions League participants.
 - Teams Qualify for following seasons Champions League based on Winter and Spring placement

NPL Relegation

- Relegation Zone created
 - Generally 2 teams per age group more in U14
- Boy's Relegation zone is added in Spring
- Girl's Relegation zone is added in Winter and Spring
- The Relegation zone teams will playoff with State Gold winners and new NPL Club teams for final NPL spots in following season
- Any teams above relegation zone automatically qualify for following years NPL
